We commit ourselves to the rights of men, women, children, youth, young adults, the aging, and people with disabilities; to improvement of the quality of life; and to the rights and dignity of all persons.

We believe in the right and duty of persons to work for the glory of God and the good of themselves and others and in the protection of their welfare in so doing; in the rights to property as a trust from God, collective bargaining, and responsible consumption; and in the elimination of economic and social distress.

We dedicate ourselves to peace throughout the world, to the rule of justice and law among nations, and to individual freedom for all people of the world.

We believe in the present and final triumph of God's Word in human affairs and gladly accept our commission to manifest the life of the gospel in the world. Amen.

# A book review of The Secret Things of God written by Dr. Henry Cloud

We all are looking for "the secret" to getting more out of life. That is definitely evidenced by the popularity of *The Secret*, a best seller and secular book by Rhonda Byrne.

Dr. Henry Cloud is a psychiatrist who uses scripture, his personal life and experiences to teach how God's mysteries answer many of the seeker's questions. He explains with knowledge from the Word, how the starting place for believers begins with seeking out God. Cloud shows how God's word differs from the teachings of Byrnes, *The Secret*.

Byrnes, *The Secret* will leave you feeling like you are missing something in your life, something that is totally within your power to get. A theme woven through her teaching is, you just need to draw what you want to yourself through the "power of attraction," to get the most out of life. That is definitely counter-culture to what the Word teaches.

*The Secret Things of God*, give you practical direction and backs it up with scripture. It takes you from the point of first believing to growing up in your salvation.

This is a well written book and the next best thing to a personal visit with a biblically knowledgeable Christian psychologist.
