News From Your District Superintendent

Colleagues and Friends:

It is hard to believe that summer is fast coming to a close and we are thinking about the fall and beyond. My daughter has been in school for most of three weeks already! "Time keeps on slippin' slippin' slippin' into the future...," as the Steve Miller band says.



With my sights on the fall, I want to share with you my plans for Church Conferences this season. Along with the other districts on our Annual Conference, Five Rivers District will be conducting Cluster Conferences. This means that a number of churches will gather at a central location and have the conferences at the same time. From two to six church/changes will gather at a host church to share in worship with Holy Communion, share celebration of local church ministries, share information and conduct the business of the church conference. This last piece, the business Prayer Requested for this of the local church/charge, will be conducted by each church in separate spaces within the host church. Or-

dained Elders from our district, and perhaps other districts, will lead these separate meetings and help each church accomplish the necessary business.

I know that we are doing a new thing with the use of Clusters. New things mean change and change is sometimes challenging. There needs to be sound reasoning for trying this new way of conducting Church Conferences. I believe that there is good reasoning. Using Cluster Conferences will allow District Superintendents to redirect a good deal of time from business meetings to relating to local churches in other ways. It is my intention to be present with churches in ways that may prove more beneficial to strengthening the ministry of the churches. Perhaps I will spend time with the Administrative Council, or with the Staff Parish Committee, or with the Visioning team of a church. I will be seeking invitations from churches to be present in ways that may prove helpful to the mission of the church. So be thinking about how this may look in your church.

Thanks for taking this journey with me. I know that I am asking something of each pastor and church. I know that there may be some who are feeling like "what else can I do, the DS said we are going to do this!" That is true, but I hope that you can see the reasoning behind the decision and come along and see if it works for us. Let's be on prayer for and with one another as we do this new thing together.
